All measurements in cm



① **Chest girth**  
Measure horizontally around the body on the widest point of the chest.

② **Waist size**  
Measure loosely around the waist.

③ **Hip size**  
Measure around hip at the widest point of the bottom.

④ **Inside leg length**  
Measure inside leg from crotch to floor.

## Shoe size table

Foot length in cm	D (EU) shoe size	UK shoe size
Up to 23,8	37	4½
Up to 24,3	38	5
Up to 25,1	39	6
Up to 25,6	40	6½
Up to 26,5	41	7½



- 1 Stand barefoot on a piece of paper of sufficient size.

Use a pen to draw two lines to mark where the big toe and heel end.



- 2 You can determine your shoe size with the table on the left using the distance between the lines in centimetres.

### Please consider the following

If your measurement results in a foot length of 25.3 cm: According to the table, a foot length of 25.1 cm corresponds to UK shoe size 6, while a foot length of 25.6 cm corresponds to shoe size 6½. Because 25.3 cm is closer to 25.1 cm than 25.6 cm, order shoe size 6 if this applies to you.
